Registration will be rejected if any required documents are not submitted 3. <u>Reservation fee (Half-day school fee: HK\$970, non-refundable)</u> **If parents decide to give up the place, please notify our school in writing. The school will then return your child's "2021/22 Registration Certificate for KG admission". (Please note, the reservation fee is non-refundable.)</p>
<p>Arrangements for children on the waiting list</p>	<p>If there are any vacancies after the centralized registration period for new students, the vacancies will be filled by children on the waiting list. Our school will notify parents by phone before 15th January 2021. Parents will need to submit the original copy of their child's "2021/22 Registration Certificate for KG admission " and pay the reservation fee HK\$970 (non-refundable).</p>
