Public Holidays)	Distribution & Submission of Application Forms Application Period: 2/10/2026 to 10/10/2026 Online Application (Self-Selected Interview Time) Method: Fill out the new student registration form via the Tai Po Baptist Kindergarten website Interview Slot: You can directly select your preferred interview time slot within the system during application. Application Fee: HK\$40 (Electronic payment; non-refundable). Crucial Note: A confirmation email will be issued upon successful registration. You must print and bring this confirmation letter with you on the interview day. In-Person School Application (Interview Time Assigned by School) Method: Obtain and submit the physical admission application form directly at the school office. Interview Slot: The exact interview time will be separately notified after form submission. Application Fee: HK\$40 (Cash payment; strictly non-refundable). Required Documentation: - Copy of the child's Birth Certificate (or a copy of valid Hong Kong residency documents). - One recent passport-sized photo of the child (affixed securely onto the application form). Office & Form Submission Hours Monday to Friday: 9:15 AM – 11:30 AM & 1:15 PM – 5:00 PM Saturday: 9:00 AM – 12:00 PM (Noon) Sunday & Public Holidays: Closed Important Guidelines for Submission: - There is no maximum limit on the number of admission applications processed during this period - Every applicant is entitled to an interview opportunity upon successful submission and fee payment - Each child can only submit one application form - Applications with incomplete information or missing documentation will not be processed by the school.

Registration January 7, 2027 (Thursday) to January 9, 2027 (Saturday)	Registration Successful applicants are required to visit the school in person to complete the registration procedures and submit the following documents: - The original "2027/28 Registration Certificate" (<i>Note: Registrations with missing documents will not be processed.</i>) Registration Fee: HK\$970 for the Half-Day Class. Important Notes Regarding Registration: If an applicant opts to forfeit the offer after registration, a formal written notification must be submitted to the school. Upon receipt, the school will return the original Registration Certificate; however, the registration fee paid is strictly non-refundable. - For official withdrawals, a one-month advance written notice must be submitted to the school to facilitate

	the return of the Registration Certificate and necessary administrative processing. Please note that the registration fee paid remains strictly non-refundable.
Waitlist Arrangements	· Upon the completion of registration for regularly admitted students, any remaining vacancies will be offered to waitlisted applicants in sequential order. · The school will individually notify parents of waitlisted students to visit the campus for registration on or before January 11, 2027 (Monday). Upon registration, parents must submit the original "2027/28 Registration Certificate" and settle the registration fee of HK\$970.
