November 5 or 12, 2022 (Saturday)	Interview for new students (Individual Appointment) (Please note, if your child is not able to communicate in Cantonese, the school can arrange an interview in either English or Mandarin.)
December 7, 2022 (Wednesday)	Announcement of interview results ~ Results will be available on our school website and parents will receive a formal letter and an email with the interview result.
Centralized Registration Dates January 5, 2023 (Thursday) to January 7, 2023 (Saturday)	Registration for successful applicants and payment of reservation fee. Successful applicants are required to visit the school to complete registration procedures. Please submit the following documents: 1. The original copy of your child's "2023/24 Registration Certificate for KG admission" and the letter with the interview result. 2. Registration will be rejected if any required documents are not submitted 3. <u>Reservation fee (Half-day school fee: HK\$970, non-refundable)</u> **If parents decide to give up the place, please notify our school in writing. The school will then return your child's "2022/23 Registration Certificate for KG admission", but the reservation fee will not be refunded. **Parents who withdraw their child during the school term must give the school one month's notice in writing, (Please note: the deposit is non-refundable.) so that the school can return the student's registration certificate and make relevant arrangements.
Arrangements for children on the waiting list	If there are any vacancies after the centralised registration period for new students, the vacancies will be filled by children on the waiting list. Our school will notify parents by phone before 14th January 2023. Parents will have to submit the original copy of their child's "2023/24 Registration Certificate for KG admission " and pay the reservation fee HK\$970 (non-refundable).

Admission Criteria:

The school's policy on admission gives priority consideration for the following points:

1. The child's interview performance (Individual and group activities will be arranged.)
2. Priority consideration is given to sibling(s) of current and graduate students, parent who is a staff member of any organization under Tai Po Baptist Church, and parents who agree to our school's vision and mission as well as learning style.
